Subject: Safety on the Highway and Protecting the General Public

We encourage all of our members and their employees to follow all the rules and regulations as described in Title 75, Pennsylvania Law. All debris and petroleum-based products must be removed from the highway before leaving an accident scene, breakdown, or recovery. This includes all hazardous materials and liquids that may cause harm to the traveling public. The following law can be used as justification for additional billing on your invoice. You are ultimately responsible to neutralize the highway to avoid further incident or damage.

Please review the following law noted below as it appears in Title 75.

Title 75 - VEHICLES - PA General Assembly

3709. Depositing waste and other material on highway, property or waters.

Chapter 37. Miscellaneous Provisions

Subchapter A. Offenses in General

(c) Removal of material following accident. --Any person removing a wrecked, damaged or disabled vehicle from a highway shall remove from the highway or neutralize any glass, oil or other injurious substance resulting from the accident or disablement.
